Summary:	The function of the RAC and its members is to advise and assist the Company as requested and assigned by the board in relation to matters relevant to or arising out of the Company's operations and activities in the particular service region for which the RAC is established.

Position Responsibilities

- To attend and constructively participate in RAC meetings as scheduled by the RAC Chairperson
- Provide advice and insights to the Service on matters affecting the community region they represent that are relevant to the operation of the Service in the region
- Identify opportunities and offer suggestions to the Service on initiatives to promote the Service and improve community engagement and support
- Provide feedback to the Service on proposed initiatives and programs and their relevancy for the region
- Assess the level of community support and engagement in the region and provide these insights to the Service
- Be a positive ambassador for the Service in the region and, where possible, participate in activities to promote the Service in the community
- Where appropriate, liaise with the Service's fundraising and marketing teams in relation to events, fundraising activities, sponsor relationships in the community they are representing
- Carry out other tasks as assigned by the RAC Chairperson and/or Board
- Act in a manner that is consistent with the Service's Board Constitution, Strategy and Values
- To act honest, maintain confidentiality and act in good faith
